Actions/Progress since Nov. 2018

- APC held WebEx meetings on December 6th, February 5th and March 7th to progress the work of the committee. All meetings met the quorum and had between 7 to 10 members plus participation from EULO and the Secretariat. Outcomes since last APC report include:
 - **Program Standards**
 - Further revised standards (A2, C4, F1, and F4) reflecting feedback from the CEO forum in Nov. 2018. Submitted to CEO meeting May 2019.
 - Developed new standard **Preventing Sexual Exploitation and Abuse** as requested by CEO forum November . Submitted to May CEO forum.
 - Recommend that this new standard becomes a new area called “Prevention of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse”.
 - **Gender position paper**
 - A sub committee (EULO, New Zealand, Barnfonden, Educo) completed a draft Gender Position Paper. It draws on like minded INGO good practice and consulted with gender experts. Extensive discussion within APC focused on the balance between policy and practice within the position paper.
Submitted to May CEO forum.



Actions/Progress since Nov. 2018

■ Programming

- APC remains engaged in implementation of CFAcc including continued piloting and expanding CFAcc. APC Chairs have consulted with Faith Nimineh to discuss the process for adopting CFAcc materials for integration and mainstreaming. Future formal relationship between APC and CFAcc Task Force still needs to be agreed
- EVAC work has expanded in many countries with evidence to be presented at the May face-to-face meeting. Efforts continue to link program outcomes to INSPIRE indicators across multiple countries.
- Mapping of member activities in the environment and climate change area has commenced to inform the emerging climate change strategy document.
- Mapping of child trafficking/ CSEC(Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children) also commenced and in early stages.
- APC members were instrumental in sourcing case studies and program examples for the key advocacy documents over past 6 months.



Actions/Progress since Nov. 2018

■ Programming (continue)

- APC increasingly used as a forum for sharing cross-country capacity development opportunities e.g. Child Safeguarding regional training in Asia and Africa (hosted by Educo); Child Protection workshop in Bangkok (hosted by International); CFAcc sharing (hosted by CCFC India) .
- Sub-committee set up to finalize the APC face-to-face meeting based on an agenda agreed through APC meetings.
- With the appointment of new CPiE/DRR Advisor the APC seeks to develop a close working relationship and have input to decisions of this taskforce.
- Change of Chairs will also be discussed in face-to-face meeting in May.
