Country/Location: **Bolivia / City of Tarija and peri-urban communities**

Title of Emergency: **Fire**

General overview (for EXTERNAL use)

After a hard work of control with an extended team that arrived in La Paz, Cochabamba as of a brigade of firemen of the Republic Argentina that arrived with equipment and helicopter, progressively it was controlling points of active fire. The Sunday morning (13/8/17), it only had had two active sites of fire in the Serranía de San Pedro de Sola and Guerra Huayco; already at the beginning of the afternoon COE issued the communiqué indicating that all the points of fire had been controlled, closing the active stage of the fire control and starting a new one that will focus on monitoring, control and rehabilitation of the affected areas.

The balance of the emergency stop: 2 people dead and 10700 hectares so directly affected by the fire. The COE is still active and immediately it has given way to the stage of monitoring and rehabilitation.

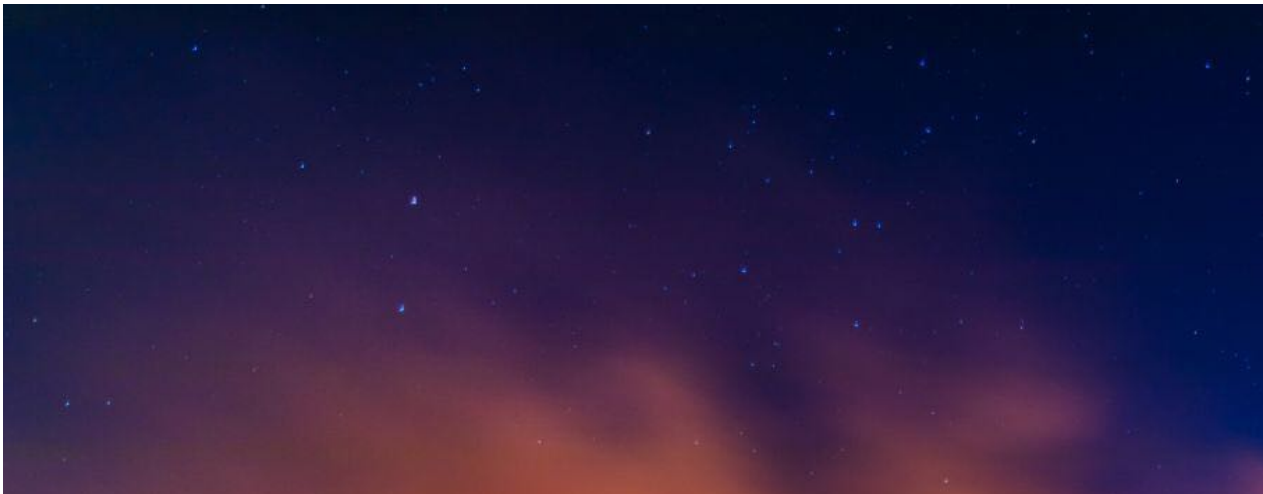
