General overview (for EXTERNAL use)

After a hard work of control with an extended team that arrived in La Paz, Cochabamba as of a brigade of firemen of the Republic Argentina that arrived with equand helicopter, progressively is was controlling points of active fire. The Sunday morning (13/8/17), it only had had two active sites of fire in the Serranía de Sal communities of San Pedro de Sola and Guerra Huayco; already at the beginning of the afternoon COE issued the communiqué indicating that all the points of fibeen controlled, closing the active stage of the fire control and starting a new one that will focus on monitoring, control and rehabilitation of the affected areas.

The balance of the emergency stop: 2 people dead and 10700 hectares so directly affected by the fire. The COE is still active and immediately it has given way a stage of monitoring and rehabilitation.




