Part 1: Overall Situation

• Situation in the country (Target area)

South Sudan update:

- As of May 15th May 2020 the total number of confirmed cases in South Sudan is now 231, with 1 death case registered on the 14th of May 2020.
- The situation remains volatile after the relaxation of restrictions on COVID-19 prevention by the government.
- At the time of this report only the previous 3 recoveries remain.

■ Part 2: Organization's Response or Plan for response

CRSO continues to abide by the measures taken by the government to ensure the safety of its staff and beneficiaries.

At the office:

• CRSO encourages all staff to follow measures put in place to keep safe

At the project site:

- The school remains closed but the teachers and the school administration remain on duty from 08:00 Am to 01:00 PM. They do planning and preparation of their schemes of work.
- All previous measures put in place by CRSO to minimize staff and beneficiary safety will remain in force unless decided otherwise.

• Security and Logistics

There continues to be armed clashes between National Salvation Front (NAS) and South Sudan Defense Forces in the equatorial region, raising further the issue of economic collapse.

CRSO will monitor such developments seriously to ensure its staff are not exposed to risk when implementing projects.

· Partnership and Coordination

CRSO remains in contact with the South Sudan NGO Forum who regularly shares updates for the partners about the COVID 19 pandemic. In addition, CRSO regularly gets updates about the security situation in the country. By sharing information with the NGO Forum, CRSO is highly updated about issues affecting operations of NGOs in the country.
