Key Deliverables

During the last six months the Task Force, led by the Secretariat, reviewed and updated the following documents for the Alliance members:

- The [Term of Reference \(TOR\)](#) for the Task Force to reflect the change in the global terminology from “**Emergencies**” to more broadly “**Humanitarian Actions**”.
- The TOR for the [Humanitarian Assistance Communication Unit](#). This mechanism exists to facilitate rapid communication to Alliance members about the nature of a humanitarian crisis.
- The [Coordination Mechanism for Alliance Humanitarian Action-](#) this paper describes the mechanism for coordinating the responses of members agencies to new or existing emergencies or humanitarian crisis.
- The Task Force also collaborated with the APC to host an on-line interactive event on child protection and our COVID-19 response, with a focus on localization.
- It was attended by 67 participated members from the field and headquarters.
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In February 2021, the Task Force prepared a paper for the CEO Forum on the future of Child Protection in Emergencies and Disaster Risk Reduction. The paper highlights the key recommendations from the Task Force meeting in Bangkok (2019) based on emerging trends in the humanitarian development sector:

1. Strengthen ChildFund internal capacity on humanitarian actions.
2. Increase our focus on child and youth participation in climate actions.
3. Support the Localization Agenda and the Grand Bargain.
(The Grand Bargain is an agreement between humanitarian organizations and donors to channel more funding to the local level.)
4. Create and maintain an internal Emergency Stand-by Roster.



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Future Directions for FY '22

1. Develop a position paper on the changing nature of child protection in humanitarian crisis and its implications for the Alliance.
2. Establish & reinvigorate key protocols for Alliance work in humanitarian crisis.
3. Commission research on the relationship of End Violence against Children & Climate Change.
4. Develop internal capacity for young people to engage safely in DRR.
5. Monitor and support the Alliance long-term response to COVID-19.
6. Identify key learnings from the COVID-19 response plan to inform the localization agenda.
