ChildFund is working in close relationship with provincial departments in 4 provinces and closely monitoring the increase of COVID-19. The law to place state in emergency is endorsed by King. There is no restricted travel. There are two new cases of COVID-19, with a total of 124 included 122 cases recovered.
