2. Overview of ChildFund response (for EXTERNAL use)

We have received updated information from our Local Partners, based on community outreach carried over during the day:

1. ADP (Área Qeqchí-Achí)

No incidents.

2. Renacimiento (Área altiplano Central)

Two children and their families (registered –not yet sponsored) whose homes have suffered damage. Our Local Partner will follow up according to our Emergency Response Protocols.

3. Tierra Nueva (Área altiplano occidental)

Two children and their families (registered –not yet sponsored) whose homes have suffered damage. Our Local Partner will follow up according to our Emergency Response Protocols.

4. Pies de Occidente (Área Kiché)

No incidents.

5. CDRO (World Bank Project-El Quiché)

No incidents.

6. Acodihue (World Bank Project-Occidente)

Severe damage to the house of a Mother Guide who is currently participating in the project. Community Bella Vista, Municipality of Santiago Chimaltenango, Huehuetenango. The whole family has sought shelter with other family members.

We will continue monitoring the current situations.
