**II. Emergency situation description**

Santa Cruz as región has declared Health emergency due to Flu AH1N1, In the area where ChildFund works there are 2 deceases, a child and an adult. Non of them are related with enrolled families.

Education authorities suspended school and preschool activities in a school near the Project Villa Alegre for disinfection and fumigation of the school and the project.

**III. Situation report in ChildFund intervention area**

The neighborhood Villa Primero de Mayo is declared in health emergency, local authorities closed some schools and Villa Alegre Project for fumigation.

**IV. Possible impact with ChildFund operations, sponsorship or programs**

Until now there are no other reports of enrolled children with the flu or their relatives. Today May 7<sup>th</sup> the Project is closed and non of the staff is working until local authorities prepare fumigation. Non of the staff is sick with the flu but can't attend work.

**V. Precaution actions**

A month ago the Program Villa Alegre told all population: children, parents and staff to use gel alcohol to prevent infection.

Since May 8<sup>th</sup> the Project Villa Alegre is closed for fumigation and until local health authorities give authorization to open again.

**VI. Immediate actions**

Project Villa Alegre will purchase chinstraps and gel alcohol for distribution with families and children. Local funds will be used for it.

**VII. Interinstitutional coordination**

Project Villa Alegre coordinated actions with neighborhood committee and education local authorities to promote fumigation in the area and other schools.
