

## Philippines Flash Update

### General overview

This is just to provide key update on Ty Opong (Bualoi)

- **Current Status:** As of Wednesday morning, Opong had sustained winds of 85 km/h and gusts up to 105 km/h, moving west-southwest at 15 km/h.
- **Forecast:** It is expected to strengthen into a typhoon by Thursday, then make landfall in Bicol and cross Southern Luzon until Saturday morning.
- **Rainfall Warnings:**
- **Sept 25–26:** Intense to torrential rain (>200 mm) in Sorsogon and Northern Samar; heavy to intense rain (100–200 mm) in Camarines Norte, Camarines Sur, Albay, Catanduanes, Masbate, Eastern Samar, and Samar.
- **Sept 26–27:** Metro Manila, Aurora, Bulacan, Pampanga, Quezon, Cavite, Batangas, Laguna, and Rizal are expected to receive heavy to intense rainfall

### Situation in ChildFund Program Area

- Ty Opong has the potential of affecting three program areas of the CO including the National Capital Region where our office is and Alliance partners areas.
- Of the Alliance partner EDUCO area is the most at risk

### Overview of ChildFund's Key Action taken and preparedness

- Local Partners from the Luzon Cluster just finished training last week on the UNICEF Prepositioned Humanitarian Project.
- Local Partners REINA and FACE (local partners with areas facing the Pacific Ocean) activated their respective ERT's already.

- CF Alliance meeting is scheduled this afternoon to discuss preparedness and anticipatory actions.
- Developed Terms of Reference for first deployment team for ChildFund F Country Office staff is prepositioned already.
